City of Hawarden For the reproduction, enlarging, mounting, and framing of photos that represent Hawarden's history (i.e. Calliope Village, various floods, railroad history, etc.). Photos, classified into themes/eras, will be displayed in the hallways of City Hall and can be used as educational tools for school students, citizens, and visitors.	\$8,500
City of Hawarden Support toward installing fence caps on both softball fields to increase safety of players and enhance appearance.	\$1,500
Hawarden Park & Recreation Plan to erect a frisbee golf course within Central Park. Funds to purchase tee signs and supplies, message boards, and trash cans.	\$1,944
Youth Football League Committee To purchase football gear and equipment to start a youth football league for 3 rd and 4 th grade youth to compete with similar teams in surrounding communities.	\$2,280

Hawarden Public Library Collaborative project between the city, library, schools, and county naturalist is to create an Outdoor Library Lab / Classroom complete with wireless internet access, native plants & trees, an area for storytelling and/or movies, and an area for educational programs. Support toward the cost of landscaping materials, plants, trees, and watering system.	\$6,000
West Sioux Elementary School/Hawarden Center Funds to support Positive Behavior Support (PBS) program used in addressing behavior expectations at Hawarden and Ireton Centers; specifically for incentives for students and training for teachers.	\$500

Rotary Club of Rock Valley Foundation, Inc. Funding to support volunteer expenses of meals and transportation reimbursement for two new Hawarden volunteer foster grandparents to help children in West-Sioux Elementary School and Head Start to reach their social and academic goals.	\$1,581
