<b>Hawarden Community Hospital Auxiliary</b> Support for costs of expanding the downtown Thrift Shop into the building adjacent to its current location.	\$5,000
<b>Sioux County Conservation Board</b> Toward the purchase and installation of a handicap accessible fishing pier at the Big Sioux Recreation Area.	\$15,000
