Sioux City Community Theatre (Sioux City, IA) Funding for royalty costs for five productions. Access to the Arts Project will provide free tickets to more than 1,200 low-income people.	\$5,000
Sioux City Parks and Recreation Department (Sioux City, IA) For the showing of eight movies in Grandview Park during the summer of 2008. Project will provide an opportunity for quality family time.	\$1,200
Sioux City Symphony Orchestra Association (Sioux City, IA) Funding will offer a 4th grade school concert that will tie directly to the district's curriculum. <i>Peter & the Wolf</i> performance will introduce the concept of an orchestra to young audiences.	\$10,000

Sioux City Public Library (Sioux City, IA) Support for "One Book One Siouxland", a community-building initiative that encourages Siouxlanders to read & discuss the contemporary memoir, "Rocket Boys/October Sky". Community-building discussion will occur at facilitated and scheduled times in public libraries, area coffee shops, informal classroom settings, etc.	\$4,000
Siouxland Senior Center (Sioux City, IA) To purchase musical instruments, karaoke machine, and art supplies to enable the Center to expand music and art programs and provide educational and recreational programming for the new PACE Adult Day Health Center.	\$10,000

Boys Club of Sioux City (Sioux City, IA) Support for <i>Math U See</i> , a math instructional program that incorporates multi-sensory educational tools to help kids with low math proficiency levels to master basic math concepts.	\$10,000
Community Action Agency of Siouxland (Sioux City, IA) Funding for developmentally appropriate playground equipment at the Townview Head Start facility, as well as for safe fall surfacing, signage, and fencing to enclose 38' x 38' area.	\$10,000
East High School - Music Department (Sioux City, IA) Funding for installation of internet access and cable TV capabilities, as well as for notebook computers and specialized instructional software to offer an alternative learning experience when performance is not an option.	\$9,500
Irving Elementary School (Sioux City, IA) To purchase new and/or used repairable instruments so all students can participate in the band program (have 22 instruments and 52 students in the program).	\$8,000

Jackson Recovery Centers, Inc. (Sioux City, IA) Support to train entry level personnel to assume roles as substance abuse counselors. Funding for curriculum materials, three computers, printer, and TV/DVD player.	\$10,000
Mary J. Treglia Community House (Sioux City, IA) To provide ESL evening classes, purchase additional class materials, and hire childcare providers when parents/caregivers are attending class.	\$15,200
SHIP - Siouxland Human Investment Partnership (Sioux City, IA) Funding for Beyond the Bell – Service Learning Projects that help students apply their academic skills, make decisions that have real consequences, develop leadership skills, and learn about teamwork.	\$10,000
Sioux City Community School District (Sioux City) Support for an aquatics program serving special needs students. Program will provide swimming instruction, movement exploration and expand gross motor skills necessary for maximum growth and development.	\$9,936
South Dakota Parks and Wildlife Foundation (for Adams Homestead – North Sioux City, SD) Funding for mountain lion exhibit that will include signage and interpretive programming for school groups, tourists, etc.	\$1,200

Boys & Girls Home & Family Services, Inc. (Sioux City, IA) For the purchase of supplies for two therapeutic play rooms and licensure for a play therapist.	\$10,000
Crittenton Center (Sioux City, IA) Funds to purchase a used seven-passenger van to transport children to and from school, doctor, and therapy appointments; and to community events on weekends.	\$10,000
CSADV - Council on Sexual Assault and Domestic Violence (Sioux City, IA) Funding for the purchase of women and children’s clothing to have available for victims of sexual assault and/or domestic violence immediately after the assault.	\$10,000
Food Bank of Siouxland, Inc. (Sioux City, IA) Support for the “BackPack” Food Program. Food will be sent home with chronically hungry children each Friday to help alleviate weekend hunger.	\$18,600
Girls Incorporated of Sioux City (Sioux City, IA) To implement the "Allies in Action" curriculum program that teaches girls to effectively navigate conflict in social situations and create constructive change in relationships. Staff and volunteers will receive training in the curriculum.	\$12,300
