<b>American Legion Auxiliary, Post 365 (Moorhead, IA)</b> <i>Fiscal Sponsor is City of Moorhead.</i> Support for remodel of bathroom and kitchen at Legion Hall.	\$3,610
<b>American Legion, Post 496 (Mapleton, IA)</b> <i>Fiscal Sponsor is the City of Mapleton.</i> Support for bathroom renovation, including sinks, cabinets and flooring, at Legion Hall.	\$3,078

<b>Rodney Community Betterment Committee (Rodney, IA)</b> <i>Fiscal Sponsor is City of Rodney.</i> Funds will go toward materials and installation costs for roof replacement of Rodney Community Center.	\$3,728
<b>Sherman Township (Blencoe, IA)</b> Funds will be used to remove, restore and reinstall flag poles and gates and purchase 25 new flags in Graceland Cemetery, with goal of improving appearance and perpetuating Avenue of Flags.	\$1,382
