\$500

To purchase a digital camera and memory cards for 8th grade students to use digital photography to create a multi-media presentation about what it means to be a “Warrior”.

Sergeant Bluff-Luton Middle School (Niki Dewald)

\$500

Toward the purchase of 24-remote system of Qwizdom for 8th grade math. Qwizdom remote technology creates a hands on learning environment. The technology will increase student engagement and participation while providing immediate feedback to students.

\$500

To purchase visual timers for 1st grade classrooms. Students in need of assistance in completing classroom assignments in allotted time will be able to use the timers to help them focus on completion of assigned tasks.
