<u>Arts and Culture</u>	
Calliope Village (Hawarden, IA) Funding toward publishing a self-guided tour booklet, development of a web page, and to purchase two new signs to provide historical information about the Village and promote it as a tourism site.	\$3,500
Sioux County Historical Society (Orange City, IA) Group wants to continue expanding and defining the exhibits and immigration story displays. Granted funds toward sliding glass doors for costume display cabinet, overhead track lighting for Middle & South Galleries to better display farm tool exhibits, and for new interior signage throughout entire museum.	\$4,000

American Red Cross, Siouxland Area Chapter (Sioux City, IA) Granted funds for 40 cots, 40 pillows, and 40 unisex comfort kits to be stored with Sioux County Emergency Services as part of the disaster and emergency preparedness plan.	\$1,960
Boyden Park and Recreation Department (Boyden, IA) Funding to purchase 6 new poles and lighting structures for the West Ball Diamond. Lighting structures have not been replaced since the mid 1970's and are unreliable as well as unsafe.	\$3,000
City of Rock Valley (Rock Valley, IA) Toward the purchase of 20 five-foot evergreens for the handicapped accessible area overlooking the Rock River at the new Rivers Bend Campground.	\$3,000
Sioux County Dive Team (Orange City, IA) Funding to purchase two dry suits for members of the Dive Team.	\$4,200
Sioux County Fireman's Association (Orange City, IA) <i>Fiscal Sponsor is the Sioux County Board of Supervisors.</i> To purchase 2 Liberty grain bin and silo rescue systems and 7 full-body rescued-rated harnesses for use throughout Sioux County.	\$9,900
Sioux County Youth Fair Association (Sioux Center, IA) <i>Fiscal Sponsor is Northwest Iowa Education Foundation.</i> In order to provide improved space for 4-H'ers and FFA members to exhibit their work at the Sioux County Youth Fair, a new building will be constructed on the current fairgrounds. Funding toward new building to be completed by the summer of 2009.	\$10,000

City of Ireton (Ireton, IA)

\$5,000

City of Ireton currently has no source for local medical care. Through an agreement with the Hawarden Community Hospital, a family practice clinic will be established in a previous clinic's location. The Hospital and Mercy Medical Services will own & operate the clinic in the space leased from the City of Ireton. Old clinic site has not been remodeled for 40 years and is not handicap accessible. Support toward remodeling project.

Human Services

Family Crisis Centers of NW Iowa (Sioux Center, IA)

\$10,000

By June 2009, will construct a new office complex, emergency shelter, and transitional housing units to provide a safe refuge for families experiencing domestic violence or sexual assault. Funding for capital campaign support.

Inspiration Hills Camp and Retreat Center (Inwood, IA)

\$1,000

Goal is to expand existing individual based high ropes course and add a 30' pamper pole to it to help youth in goal setting, overcoming fears, and building teamwork. Funding toward course expansion.
