<b><u>Arts and Culture</u></b>	
<b>Orange City Arts Council (Orange City, IA)</b> Support toward portable display panels/equipment and brochures to promote project exhibits that travel to various public locations in the county to provide opportunities for artists to share their creations.	\$2,000
<b><u>Civic and Community</u></b>	
<b>Boyden Ambulance Service (Boyden, IA)</b> To purchase Life Pak 12 and Life Pak 1000 defibrillators to stay in compliance with State of Iowa requirements.	\$2,000
<b>Boyden Park &amp; Recreation Department (Boyden, IA)</b> Toward the purchase of play features for a 3,000 sq. ft. zero-entry depth splashpad in Centennial Park. Project will complete the original 1989 Park plan and be a free amenity for the community.	\$10,000
<b>City of Hospers (Hospers, IA)</b> Playground Equipment Committee receiving support to purchase a tower unit that includes slides, swings, bouncers, etc. to update existing playground at Southside Park and will accommodate individuals who are physically handicapped.	\$10,000
<b>Granville Fire Department (Granville, IA)</b> Toward the purchase of a thermal imaging camera and equipment that will allow firemen to more quickly and safely locate a fire.	\$8,000
<b>Hawarden Park &amp; Recreation Department (Hawarden, IA)</b> Plan to erect a frisbee golf course within Central Park. Funds to purchase nine disc baskets for the course.	\$2,898
<b>Hull Parks &amp; Recreation Department (Hull, IA)</b> Funding for construction of covered dugouts at new little league (ages 5-12) ball field as participants in summer ball programs have increased and City currently has only one municipal field.	\$5,000
<b>Ireton Fire Department (Ireton, IA)</b> Grant funding will be added to money raised in community to purchase a new pumper truck. Current 1978 truck no longer meets NFPA standards.	\$5,000
<b>Maurice Women's Club (Maurice, IA)</b> <i>Fiscal sponsor is City of Maurice.</i> Toward equipment and supplies needed to update restrooms at Maurice Park.	\$500
<b>Sioux County Fireman's Association</b> Support to outfit Sioux County fire fighters (200 volunteers) with a traffic safety vest and provide each fire department with traffic cones and "Emergency Scene Ahead" signs in order to be compliant with new US Dept. of Transportation law.	\$8,300
<b>Sioux County Youth Fair Association</b> Toward sidewalk improvements and landscaping around the newly constructed all-seasons building at the Sioux County Fairgrounds.	\$5,000

<b>Center for Financial Education (Sioux Center, IA)</b> Funds to provide scholarships for low-income families to attend Financial Peace University (FPU) classes, a 13 week session covering all the basics of financial education.	\$1,250
<b>Hawarden Public Library (Hawarden, IA)</b> Collaborative project between the city, library, schools, and county naturalist to create an Outdoor Library Lab / Classroom complete with wireless internet access, native plants & trees, an area for storytelling and/or movies, and an area for educational programs. Funding for project's watering system.	\$6,500
<b>Sioux County Library Association</b> Toward equipment, materials, and software for various needs of County libraries.	\$5,000
<b><u>Health</u></b>	
<b>Greater Sioux Community Health Center (Sioux Center, IA)</b> Funds used to train GSCHC staff, purchase books, promote breast feeding and smoking cessation to enhance education provided during well-child visits targeted for infants to 5 yr. olds and their parents.	\$8,913
<b><u>Human Services</u></b>	
<b>ATLAS Orange City Area (Orange City, IA)</b> To purchase materials and resources to increase the "library" of resources to help area people resolve daily issues and more effectively train mentors.	\$2,500
<b>Family Crisis Centers of NW Iowa (Sioux Center, IA)</b> Toward the purchase of needed furnishings and appliances for use in Harbor House - the new emergency housing facility for victims of violence or sexual assault.	\$10,000
<b>Inspiration Hills Camp and Retreat Center (Inwood, IA)</b> Funding for full body harnesses for Leap of Faith/Pamper Pole on expanded ropes challenge course to help youth in goal setting, building trust, overcoming fears, and teamwork.	\$991
<b>Justice for All (Rock Valley, IA)</b> Northwestern College public relations class students are developing a marketing plan for JFA which will include new flyers, brochures, and a PowerPoint presentation. Support toward the purchase of a laptop computer and digital projector for making presentations throughout the county.	\$2,283
<b>Sioux County Agricultural Extension District</b> As part of 'Aging in Place Expo' will have the Universal Design Trailer brought in from Iowa State University to educate the public about adaptations that can be made to existing homes; making them more accessible for the aging population. Funds to purchase universally designed gadgets that assist with everyday tasks – to be giveaways to those visiting booths at the fair.	\$1,931
